The area with its numerous different theme routes is ideal for cycling, water sports, climbing, hiking, horseback riding, golfing – or simply relaxing. 1000-year-old monasteries, castles, churches, mills and museums bear witness to the exciting history of the region and its people. The landscape varies from forests and the foothills of the low mountain range to fascinating moors, heathlands, inland dunes and vast water areas. Impressive experiences in nature are guaranteed!

The area surrounding the biggest lake in Lower Saxony, Lake Steinhuder Meer, includes parts of the Region Mittelweser, Schaumburger Land and the Nature Park Lake Steinhuder Meer. Each area has its own special charm, characterized by the unique landscapes and history.

Nature Park Lake Steinhuder Meer connects these areas and is a great example of nature protection and tourism going hand in hand. The 420 km<sup>2</sup> are characterized by vast high and lowland moors, swimming meadows, moraine landscapes, inland dunes, mountains and the heart of the nature park - Lake Steinhuder Meer. Flora and fauna in the nature park are just as diverse as the landscape. The unique natural paradise can be discovered on observation decks, adventure paths and signposted hike and bike paths, without disturbing these sensitive areas. A 32 kilometer long cycling track leads around Lake Steinhuder Meer. The shallow lake with its protected areas is a perfect breeding and resting place for wading birds and waterfowl, a true paradise for nature lovers. Observation platforms are ideal for bird watching and with a little bit of luck you might be able to see the majestic sea eagle. Thanks to comprehensive protection measures, rare species, such as the European mink and the moor duck, were reintroduced to this

Lake Steinhuder Meer is also a paradise for bathing beauties, swimmers, sailors and surfers. The promenades in Steinhude and Mardorf invite you to take a stroll and unwind, landing stages provide a maritime atmosphere and beautiful views.





Nienburg is known as the city of half-timbered houses and Weserrenaissance city and is home to many interesting museums. It is the economic and cultural center in the Region Mittelweser. This region is directly connected to several popular bike routes, such as the Weser Bike Path and big touristic bike paths like the German Half-Timbered House Path, Lower Saxony's Asparagus Route, and Lower Saxony's Windmill Street. #### 1. CITY NIENBURG/WESER

banks of the river Weser: Follow the bear's paw prints. 500 of these big white bear paws guide you on a 3.3 kilometer long tour to 32 sights of the historical old town. One of them is the *Nienburger Museum*, consisting of three historical buildings. The Fresenhof (Leinstraße 48) from

the 16th century is the museum's main building. There, you can learn more about the history of the city and county. The classicist house Quaet-Faslem-Haus (Leinstraße 4) was built by the Royal Construction Councilman of Hanover, Emmanuel Bruno Quaet-Faslem. There is also an art gallery from Nienburg's painter Ernst Thoms, a Biedermeier garden and a Lapidarium (rock collection). Lower Saxony's Asparagus Museum (Leinstraße 4) exhibits everything about asparagus, including information on its cultivation, cutting and distribution. Burgdorf's Asparagus Collection – elegant porcelain and silverware – are on display on the upper floor.

The Police Museum Lower Saxony is dedicated to the criminal case Haarmann, a man who committed his monstrous deeds as a mass murderer in Hanover in the 1920s. Explore the multifaceted police work and several police vehicles.

The brick gothic church *Pfarrkirche St. Martin*, located in the heart of the historic town center, is Nienburg's main church. With a height of 72 meters, the tower is the city's landmark. Valuable gravestones, paintings, sarcophagi and remains of paintings dating back to the Middle Ages are located inside.

## 2. ERRATIC BOULDER GIEBICHENSTEIN IN STÖCKSE

forest named Krähe near Stöckse. The granite stone, which weighs around 207 tons, was brought here from Sweden by glaciers of the Saale Ice Age. The erratic boulder plays a role in the legend of Dwarf King Giebich, hence the boulder's name. Nearby, a hunter's camp from the Stone Age and a field of Bronze Age burial mounds were located. Further information can be found along the archaeological trail.

The Monastery Mariensee has been a place of spiritual life for women for more than 800 years. The brick church built in the early Gothic period, the massive convent building from the 18th century, the flowering gardens and the monastery's museum document the history of the Protestant nunnery. In addition, there are many concerts, exhibitions, retreat days and seminars. On weekends, the monastery's café is open for visitors.

### 8. PASSENGER SHIPPING COMPANIES

Set sail and discover the landscape from the water: On the rivers Weser, Leine or Mittellandkanal on classy boats during a day trip or an individual tour. Or on Lake Steinhuder Meer in traditional wooden boats called Auswanderer, which have been used for over 100 years in Steinhude. The name derives from the German word auswandern, which means "to emigrate". Steinhude belonged to Schaumburg-Lippe and Mardorf belonged to Hanover. So, if you travelled from one place to the other, you emigrated – hence the name of the boats.

#### 9. MOOR ADVENTURE PATH

#### 10. LANDESTROST CASTLE

The castle is one of the most beautiful buildings in the Weserrenaissance style. In 1573-84, the castle was built as a representative residency and administrative office by Erich II of Braunschweig-Lüneburg. Today, the castle is owned by the foundation Kulturregion. Many events take place in the historical, elaborately restored facilities. Since 1888, Lower Saxony's only sparkling wine factory is located in the vaults of the castle. The garden area offers a wonderful view over the meadows next to the

## 11. WILHELMSTEIN ISLAND

The small island with the great history is a popular tourist destination. Count Wilhelm of Schaumburg-Lippe had the island and the small fortress built in 1761. The stellar fortress was used as a military school and up to the 19th century as the county's prison. Today, there is a museum in the fortress, a nature park info point, a hotel and a restaurant on the island. Modern passenger boats and Auswanderer, traditional wooden dinghies, take visitors from Mardorf and Steinhude to the island.

## 12. STEINHUDE

Maritime flair prevails in the fishing village on the southern shore of Lake Steinhuder Meer. Fresh smoked eel is a popular local product in Steinhude. The museums exhibit the traditional life of fishermen and weavers. There, the unique seamless shirt can also be gazed at. An exotic experience is Steinhude's Insect Museum with its hundreds of colourful butterflies in the tropical hall. The promenade is the perfect place for a stroll overlooking the lake and Wilhelmstein Island. From here, the passenger boats and traditional wooden boats take visitors to the island and Mardorf. In addition, there are numerous events, such as the Fischerkreidag or the Festive Weekend with a spectacular firework display.

## 13. BARN QUARTER STEINHUDE

After several fires in the old town center the barns were relocated to the town's outskirts in the 18th century. Today, the half-timbered house ensemble is a tourist attraction and listed as a historic monument. The houses are home to a café, tourist information, small boutiques, the Art Barn with changing exhibitions and the Nature Park Information Center with an exhibition of the EU bird sanctuary *Meerbruch* and the nocturnal animal kingdom. The virtual boat trip on Lake Steinhuder Meer is a special experience – not only on rainy days. You can also find helpful information on trips and guided tours. Markets and other events take place on the central square.

#### 18. FORMER ROYAL HOME: HAGENBURG This tour has 20 stops and interesting destinations, such as the

castle, the former summer residence for the House of Schaumburg-Lippe. The driveway is lined with rhododendrons, which turn the road into a pink and purple blaze of colour when they are in flower. On Hagenburg's nature trail in the moor garden, the moor landscape with its unique flora and fauna can be explored. In the boulder garden, the 23 huge geological natural monuments bear witness to the Ice Age. The church St. Nicolai with its west tower and panoramic view over Lake Steinhuder Meer can be seen from afar. The neo-Gothic hall church is a masterpiece by Conrad Wilhelm Hase from Hanover. Today's furnishings date back to the construction period.

Ratskeller, Röbbingsturm and many half-timbered houses complement the ensemble. Additionally, there are several fountains, which were designed by famous artists. Close by, the air base Fliegerhorst Wunstorf is located with the biggest flying unit in the German Air Force, the Air Freight Squadron 62.

## 22. ST. MARTINI CHURCH WITH MAUSOLEUM

There were several churches in medieval Stadthagen, but St. Martini was the parish church and thus the center of ecclesial life. It was built in 1318, while today's three-aisled Gothic hall church with its annexes was built during several medieval construction periods. Based on a heptagonal layout and connected to the church through a short hallway, the mausoleum of Prince Ernst of Holstein-Schaumburg is located directly behind the choir. From 1624 until the new mausoleum's completion in Bückeburg in 1916, Schaumburg's sovereigns buried their relatives here. The funerary monument depicting the resurrected Jesus rising above the sleeping guards was created by the sculptor Adriaen de Vries in his Prague atelier in 1618 and 1624. This internationally recognized artistic composition of architecture, painting and sculpture has been preserved unchanged

# 23. WILHELM BUSCH LAND WIEDENSAHL

Nestled between fields, woods and paddocks lies the old village of Wiedensahl. Here, Wilhelm Busch was born on April 15th 1832 as the eldest of seven children. And from here he ventured out into the world as a boy, to return as an artist, poet and thinker. Wiedensahl was his most important retreat and place of inspiration. The village is also the home of Max and Moritz, Pious Helen, the monkey Fipps and origin of all the picture stories and sharp-tongued rhymes. This is a place where history

## 24. MONASTERY LOCCUM

This is one of the most impressive Cistercian monasteries north of the Alps including an impressive architectural collection of buildings from 1163, such as the late Romanesque abbey church, the cloister, an impressive gatehouse and farm buildings. The preacher seminar of the Evangelical Lutheran Landeskirche Hannover is located here. The monastery is a spiritual place, cultural center, the starting point of a pilgrim path and worth seeing.
